

Module: Main Aspect of Indian Philosophy

Topic: Drag the Words - *Āstika and Nāstika*

Description:

Drag the Words - Āstika and Nāstika is an interactive learning resource designed to help learners clearly distinguish between the *āstika* and *nāstika* schools of Indian philosophy. Through a hands-on drag-and-drop format, participants engage with key characteristics, texts, and beliefs associated with each tradition. The activity reinforces understanding of which philosophical systems accept the authority of the Vedas (*āstika*, such as *Vedānta*, *Sāṃkhya*, and *Nyāya*) and which do not (*nāstika*, such as *Buddhism*, *Jainism* and *Cārvāka*). By promoting active recall and critical classification, this resource enhances conceptual clarity and encourages comparative analysis within the broader Indian philosophical landscape.
